## DISCOUNT OFFERS

- A family discount of **5%** of the tuition fees per term is given to the 3<sup>rd</sup> child and **10%** to the 4<sup>th</sup> child. This is awarded to the child of the lower class.
- A **2%** discount on full tuition fee payment for the following term and will apply on the following dates: November 30<sup>th</sup>, March 31<sup>st</sup> and July 31<sup>st</sup>.
- A **5%** discount on annual tuition fee payment will be applied on the following date: September 30<sup>th</sup> for CI Curriculum.

## SCHOOL FEES POLICY

- School Fees should be paid in full on or before the first day of the term. A learner with outstanding fees will not be allowed to sit for end of term exams.
- A learner will be required to replace any lost book issued within an academic year.
- No child will be allowed to take the extra activities UNLESS full payment is done.
- **A penalty of Kshs. 5,000/- will be charged for any dishonoured cheque** thereafter the parent will be black listed from giving any personal or company cheque.
- Caution Money is refundable less deductions due on lost or damaged property.
- A Term's notice should be given in writing of the intention to withdraw a child failure to which the caution money will be deemed forfeited.
- The caution money claim should be within a maximum of two years from the time the learner(s) leaves Rose of Sharon Academy.
- Stage 11 fee is Payable in two installments in September & January

### NOTE

All tuition fees include: French, computer classes, meals and co-curricular activities.
