




Dear Parents.



As we enter a new academic term/year, we would like to take this opportunity to update you on our school's homework policy. Our aim is to bring clarity and consistency to the process, ensuring that our learners receive the necessary support and supervision during their study time at home.

Effective from 29th August 2023

We have implemented a revised homework timetable that requires students to focus on two subjects per day. This change has been made after careful consideration and taking into account various factors such as the workload, age appropriateness, and the importance of well-rounded academic development.

Why 2 Subjects?

By assigning two subjects per day, we aim to strike a balance between a manageable workload and ensuring that all subjects receive the necessary attention.


